1 Peter 5

- Be the True Grace of God
 - Could this really be what it means to live under the grace of God?
 - o 2 Corinthians 12:7-12
- Stand Firm
 - We've been told the indicative and now we see the imperative.
 - Standing firm means relying on what we already have, not on looking for the "new and improved".
- Peace to All in Christ
 - The experience of the Giver, and not the gift.

2 Peter 1

- Multiplication of Grace and Peace
 - o A grace that builds in the life of a believer
 - Is the point of salvation to escape hell, or to be filled with Christ? Yes!
- The True Knowledge of God
 - The truth that gives us grace
 - Hebrews 12:1-2.

Application

- A people too easily distracted
 - Staying focused through the knowledge of God
 - Matthew 4:4
