


As we study more what it means to serve Jesus this Winter, we want you to take the time to think about what you are reading. Throughout the Bible, we learn what it means to follow Jesus and

Anything that shines out in the passage and draws attention; it can be something important, or something that particularly strikes the	
reader.	
Question Mark

Anything that is hard to understand; something that the reader would like to be able to ask the author about.
