Short-Term Mission Policy - 1 year or less:

- Both trip leaders and team members are encouraged to work toward raising some of their own support. We feel this is an important part of a mission trip experience.
- LifePoint members participating in LifePoint sponsored short-term trips are eligible for a maximum subsidy of up to 50% of your trip expenses, if needed and depending on the availability of funds.
- LifePoint members participating in trips not sponsored by LifePoint are eligible to apply for a maximum subsidy of 25% of your trip expenses, if needed and depending on the availability of funds.
- LifePoint members leading a LifePoint sponsored trip are eligible to apply for a subsidy of up to 100% of trip expenses, if needed and depending on the availability of funds.
- Applications for a subsidy should be submitted to the Missions Plan Group at least 60 days before funds are due.
- Priority for short-term fund assistance will be given to LifePoint members.
- In order to be eligible for short-term fund assistance, the person requesting funds (or their parents if a minor) should be actively and regularly participating in giving to the Faith Promise fund.
- Under normal circumstances this assistance is only available once every three years, but applications will be considered on an individual basis.
- In order to be approved for any short-term mission assistance, applicants must also complete, consent to and submit the LifePoint Mission Trip Application.
- Applicant agrees to comply with the LifePoint Fundraising Policy (included on reverse side).

LifePoint Church Fundraising Policy

Believing that we ought to live by the highest standard and that we should be an example to the world, we want to rely on God's promise that He is sufficient to provide for our every need – spiritual, physical and material. While this may mean that we will not do some of the great things we think we ought to do, our desire is to trust God to supply our every need to do all that we should do. We anticipate that this will normally take place as our people tithe and generously give to the work of the Lord through the church as opposed to special fund raising projects. (II Corinthians 9:8) In response to questions from various ones regarding methods of fund raising, the following guidelines are set forth:

- 1. No collections will be received during church services. Rather, offering boxes will be provided in The Commons and Worship Center for those wishing to participate in the giving to the church. (I Corinthians 16:1-2; II Corinthians 9:6-8)
- 2. Fund raising activities, such as car washes, garage sales, bazaars, bake sales, etc., for purposes of church sponsored activities should take place only with prior approval of the Board of Elders or Senior Pastor. The spirit of this cautious approach is to prevent a feeling of compulsion when people are asked to give as well as to prevent an atmosphere of business in our place of worship.
- 3. Solicitations in the church for purposes of outside fund raising activities (e.g., cookies, candy, etc.) will be strongly discouraged.
- 4. Sales of books, records, tapes, etc., by individuals or groups ministering in the church will be permitted before and after the service in which they participate.
- 5. When a number of individuals from LifePoint Church are all participating in the same short-term mission trip, one letter shall be sent representing all, rather than many individual letters. Funds donated may be designated for a specific individual or for just the general trip fund, which would be divided among those going.
- 6. Our desire is to present the need to God's people and reply on God to provide the material funds necessary to do that which God wants us to do.
- 7. All other fund raising activities will not be permitted unless there is a prior approval of the Board of Elders.
